

# **Meals on Wheels**

The year 2020 was an extraordinary one for the Nutrition Program. As the pandemic hit and the state-ordered shut down went into effect, we received an overwhelming response from the community and staff, ready to help. Volunteers were quickly signed up and trained to help in place of many of our long-time volunteers who had to temporarily step back during the pandemic.

Our Nutrition staff quickly put safety procedures and protocols in place, working together with the meal site staff and drivers. We changed to a contactless delivery, and our drivers pivoted from going inside an elder's home with a brief conversation to leaving each meal in a bag outside of an elder's home, with a knock and hello, or a wave through a window.

Through the efforts and generosity of community groups, local businesses and volunteers, we have been able to provide enough PPE so that our volunteers have face masks, hand sanitizer and wipes to keep everyone safe. The number of consumers and meals we deliver has increased rapidly, and as we needed more volunteers, we took over most of the space at our sites to be able to safely keep up with the demand. Our drivers have been consistently delivering extra shelf stable and frozen meals to consumers throughout this time.
